## A PACKARD FIRST

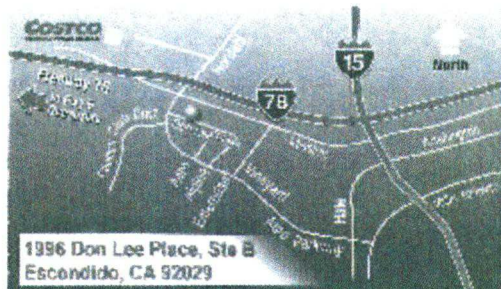

We don't often use outside luggage racks, but in the 1920s and 1930s they were very popular for expensive cars, because long tours were in vogue. This lead Packard to name their big smooth running elegant automobiles, Touring Sedans. Packard was the first by patenting a rear rack. Not seen by most of us Packardites, Packard also patented the present radiator design of top and bottom reservoirs with tubes running between. Guess this is the modern radiator we are familiar with.
