I am pleased to announce the San Diego Region 2007 Event Calendar. The Board met on Sunday January 21 in a planning session to develop a calendar of events that we believe to be exciting and responsive to the needs of the region's members. In developing this calendar we paid particular attention to the results of the survey that you filled out and returned along with your membership renewal for 2007.

Here's what the survey told us:

1) More than half of the respondents said you want more emphasis on technical training and education on the subject of Packard maintenance, repair and restoration.

Result: The 2007 calendar contains 3 Tech Sessions to be held during the year.

- 2) Two-thirds said that Cruisin' Grand is the favorite event held each year. Result: We have planned a 4-day National Tour to be held in San Diego which will be based around Cruisin' Grand. All Regions of Packards International (worldwide) will be invited to attend.
- 3) Other popular events are: swap meets, garage tours, and winery tours. **Result:** There are 3 swap meet events on the calendar, as well as a garage tour and a winery tour.
